Florence Nightingale 1820-1910 Bible reading - John 5:12

Enquiry Question: I wonder why there have been hospitals called 'Nightingale' hospitals?

Enquiry Questions: I wonder why Florence felt that her work was an important way of living out her faith? I wonder what Florence meant when she wrote "There will be no heaven for me, nor for anyone else, unless we make it, with wisdom carrying out our thoughts into realities ... We are to learn, first, what is heaven, and secondly, how to make it. We are to ascertain what is right, and then how to perform it."

Dr Thomas Barnardo 1845- 1905 Bible reading - Proverbs 31:9

Enquiry Question: I wonder what moved Thomas to act in this way and change the way things were done and attitudes towards the poor?

Dr Barnardo's words might help us to understand this. 'I have always felt a positive duty was laid upon me, to stir up the minds of Christian people generally to a greater sense of their responsibility'. He was a man of vision and action. He did not just see a need, but took immediate steps to address it.
